7	Latest two (2) years' tax declaration slip (e-BE & EA Form) with proof of tax paid	
8	Latest three (3) months' salary slip	
9	No Objection Letter (NOL) from current employer (must be in Bahasa Malaysia)	
10	A copy of the local contact person's NRIC (MyKad) (the front and back, and in colour)	
11	Local Sponsor Form (filled in with local sponsor's details)	
12	Testimonials with company's letterhead	
13	Other supporting documents, eg recommendations from Regulatory Agencies (optional)
